Clarification of Incorrect Media Article

Overland Resources Limited (ASX: OVR and 'the Company') would like to clarify information published in RESOURCESTOCKS Magazine by Aspermont Limited ('Aspermont') on 15 February 2011.

The original article written by Aspermont quoted: "...**The Andrew Zinc Deposit – a rich deposit known to host 17 base metal groups with 55 million tonnes of contained zinc and lead metal The project currently consists of two shallow high grade zinc deposits for a JORC - Code compliant resource of 8.98 million tonnes at 7.5 Zn and 1.2% Pb with a 2% zinc cut-off applied...**".

The Company confirms that it has not supplied nor approved for release any such information.

The Company has contacted Aspermont and found that the above incorrect information was due to unauthorised journalistic error. Aspermont have noted that the above JORC Resource reference is incorrect and the reference to the Andrew Zinc Deposit should have been a reference to the "Selwyn Basin in Canada". The Company has asked for the mistakes to be rectified. Aspermont have amended their online magazine and will also be making an announcement to the Australian Stock Exchange.

The Company confirms that the present JORC Code compliant resource for the Yukon Base Metal Project, applying a 2% zinc cut, off is:

8.95 million tonnes at 6.3% Zn and 1.2% Pb
